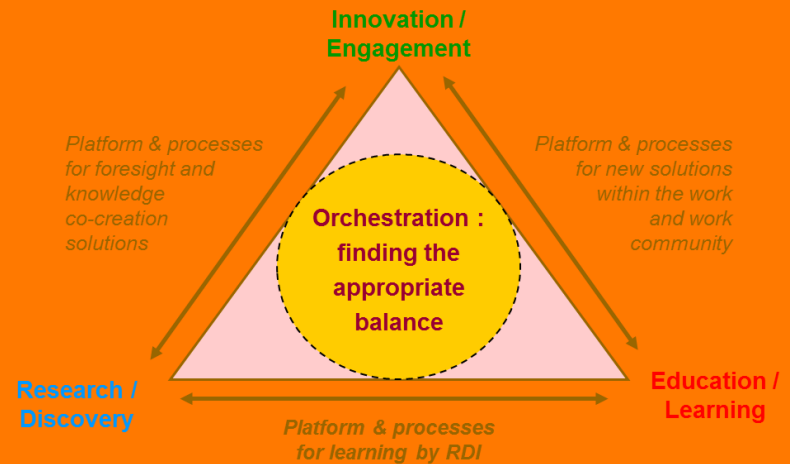
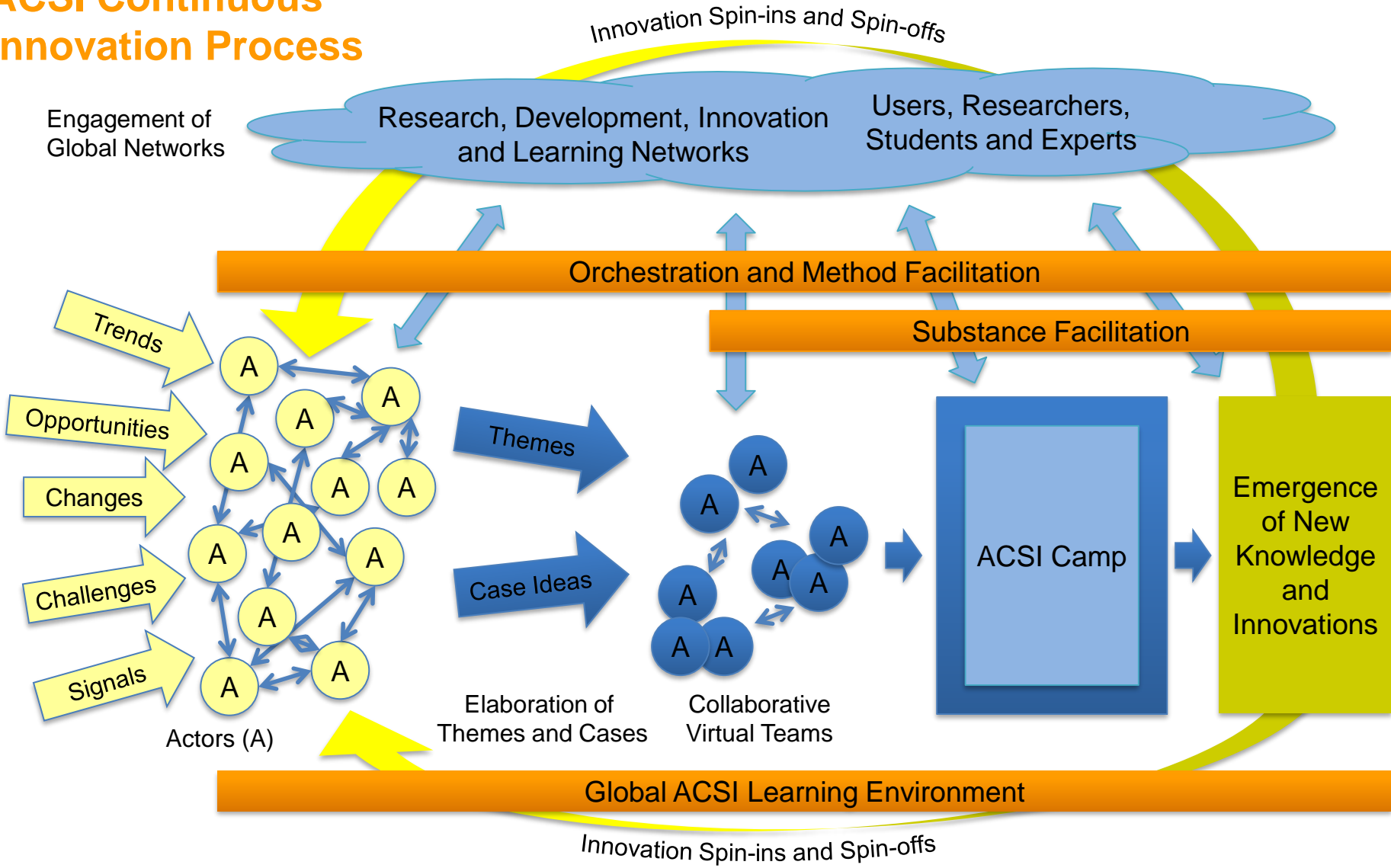


## Aalto Camp for Societal Innovation ACSI
