


Guidelines for students

for submitting applications for additional financial support for students with fewer opportunities





The application process




- Find out about your options from your institutional coordinator.
- Fill in the application form:
 - Enter your personal data and mobility details.
 - Indicate the category under which you are eligible for the additional fewer opportunities grant.
- Documents to be submitted to your Erasmus+ coordinator:
 - Completed eligibility document
 - Completed excel application form
 - A signed or digitally authenticated copy of the application form

The application evaluation process

- I. The student submits the application to the coordinator.
- II. The Erasmus+ coordinator forwards the submitted and supported. applications to Tempus Public Foundation.
- III. After the decision of the Board of Trustees of Tempus Public Foundation:
 - > The higher education institution notifies the student of the awarded additional support and includes the additional financial support in the grant agreement.
