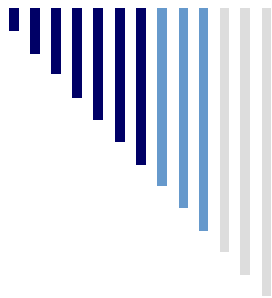

- 319,000 teachers

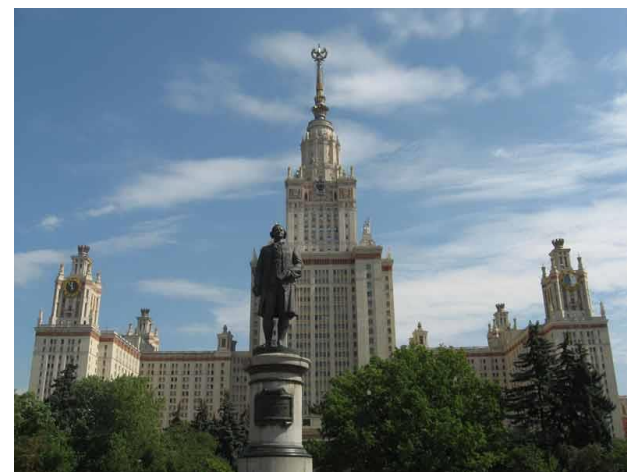
Types of HEIs:

 - Moscow State University
 - St. Petersburg State University
- 29 National Research Universities
- 10 Federal universities
- 11 Regional Flagship Universities
- 844 Public, municipal and private universities



HE Cycles

1. Bachelor – 240 ECTS credits
– about 100%
 2. Master – 120 ECTS credits
 3. Doctoral

- All first-cycle programmes give access to second cycle study programmes
 - Over 80% bachelors go on to master programmes

Latest developments

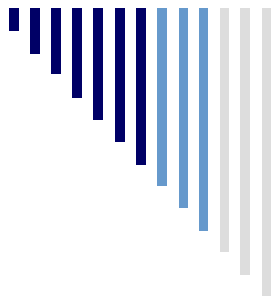
- National Council for Qualifications under the RF President

Means to achieve

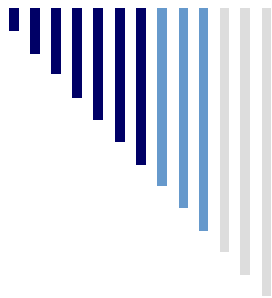
- Systemic cooperation between universities and enterprises

- Russia's participation:
 - Learning Mobility (Key action 1)
 - any students who meet the requirements of the Masters Degrees programmes
 - Russian universities in the Masters Degrees consortiums – by invitation only
 - Teachers and student mobility as part of Credit Mobility – no limits
 - Cooperation (Key action 2)
 - Russian universities and organisations take part in:
 - Strategic partnerships и Knowledge Alliances – by invitation only
 - Capacity Building:
 - in multinational projects only
 - cannot be grantholders
 - The Jean Monnet programme
 - No limits

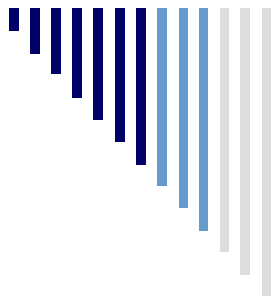


Call 2015: Russia



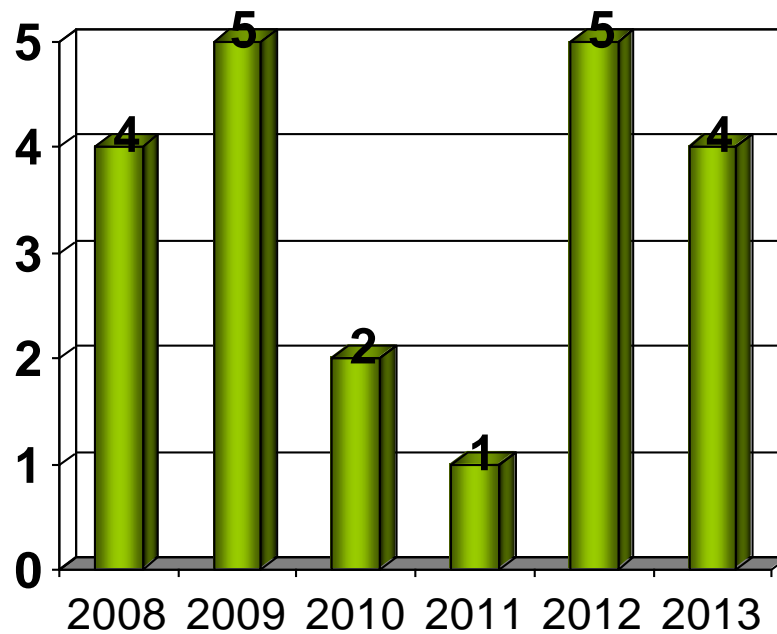

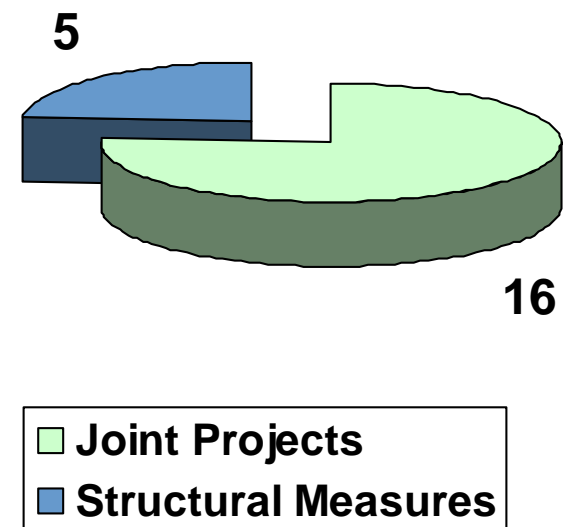


Tempus IV: Russian-Poland cooperation

Number of projects

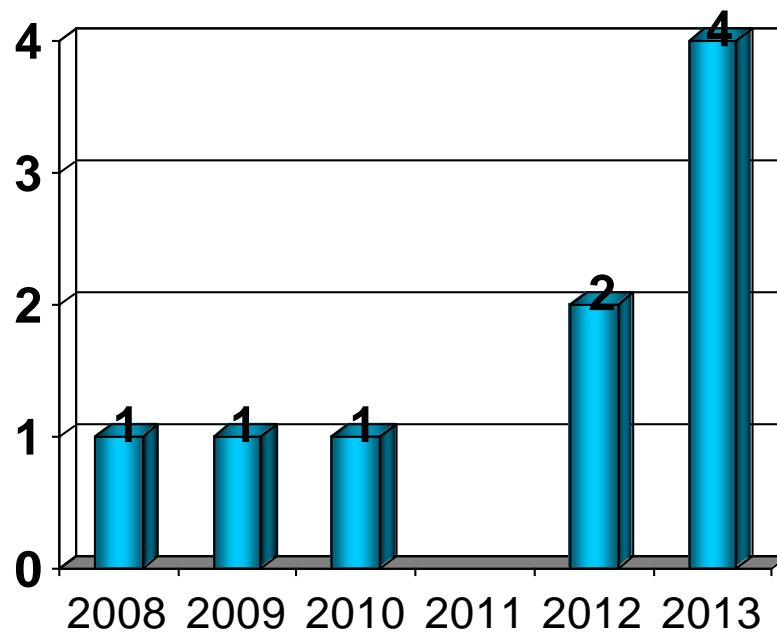


Types of projects

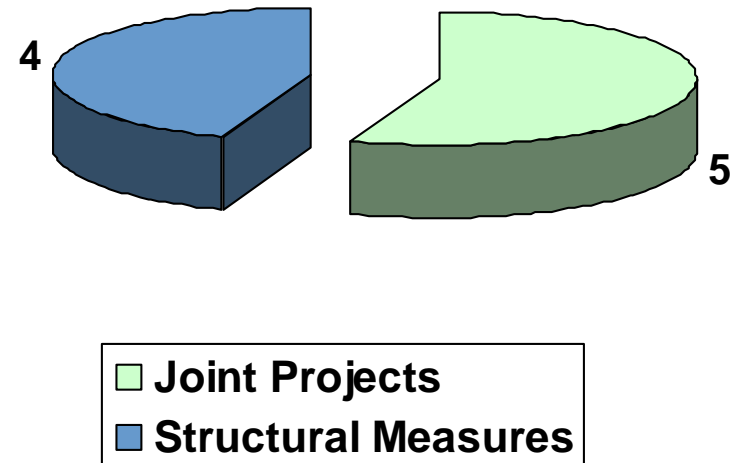


Tempus IV: Russia – Slovakia cooperation

Number of projects

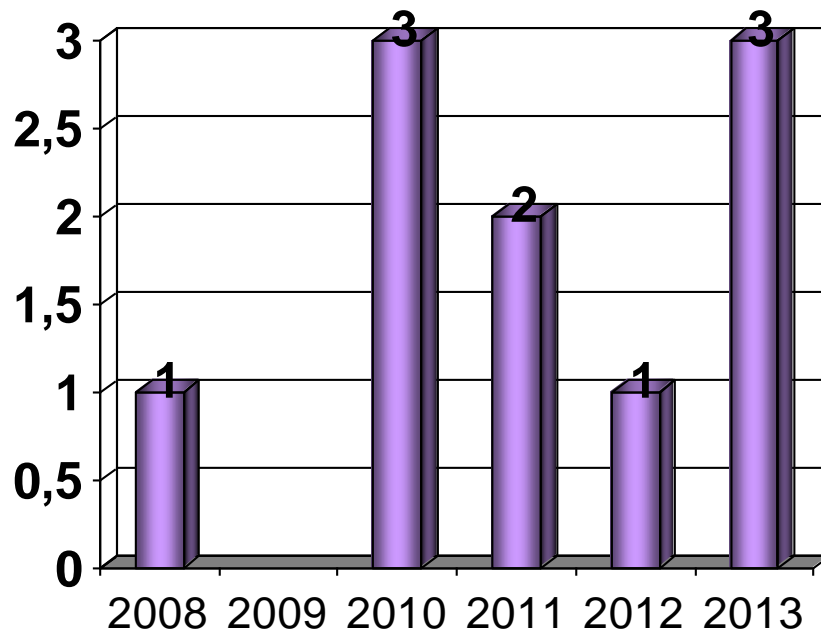

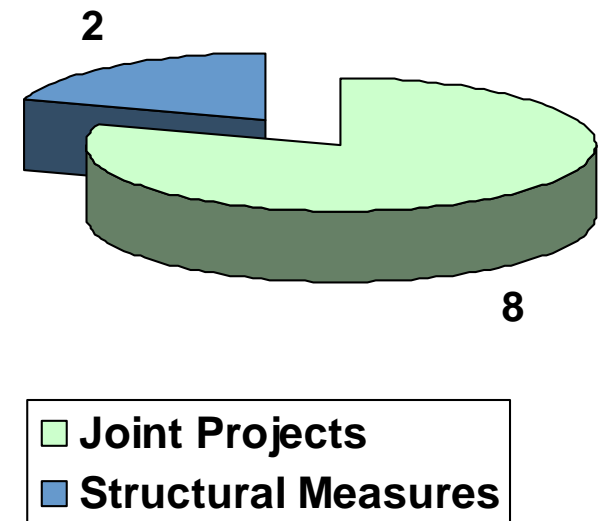


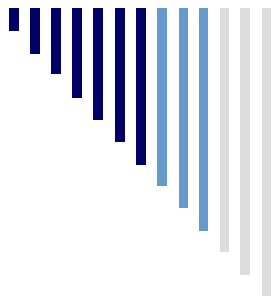
Tempus IV: Czech-Republic – Erasmus+ Russian cooperation

Number of projects



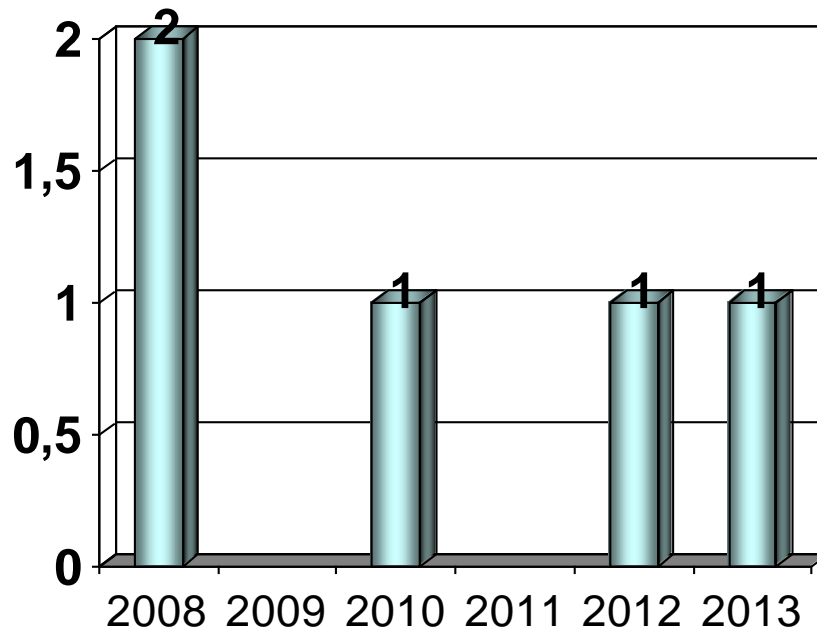

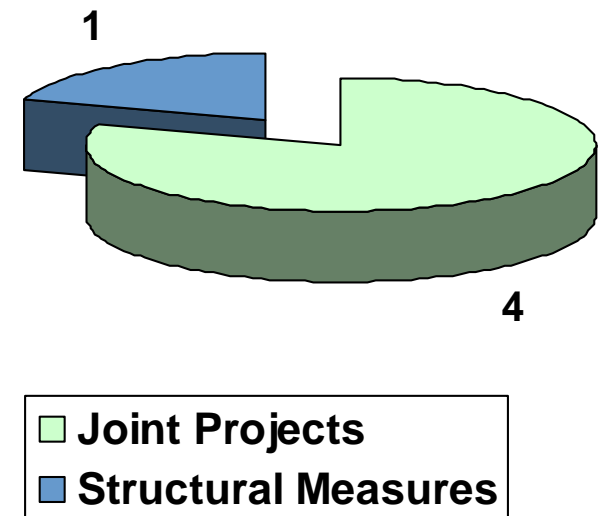


Tempus IV: Russian-Hungarian cooperation

Number of projects

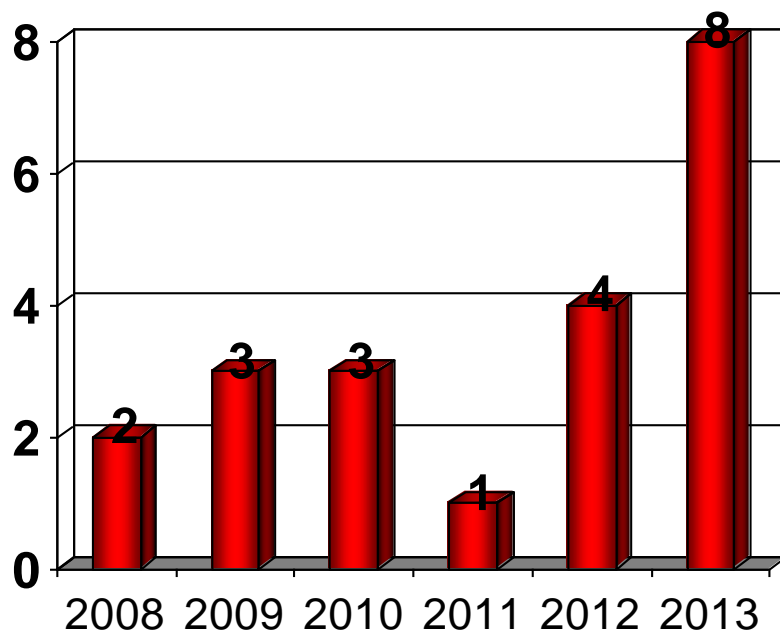

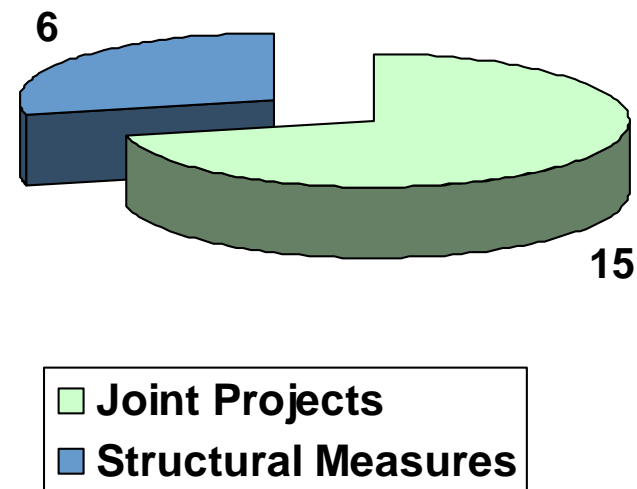


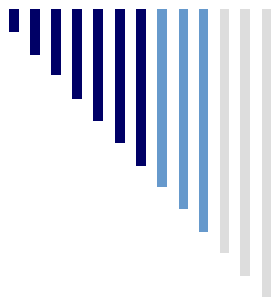
Tempus IV: Russian-Austrian cooperation

Number of projects



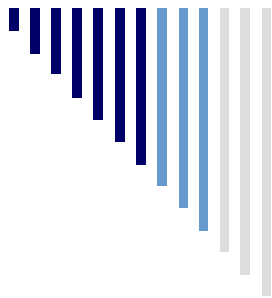
