## **CYPRUS HIGHER EDUCATION SYSTEM**

- The Republic of Cyprus has established a favourable framework for the operation of three public and seven nonpublic Universities, as well as a large number of Public and Private Institutions of HE.
- Cypriot Universities and Institutions of HE offer a variety of undergraduate and postgraduate programmes of study. They target quality, invest in their human resource development and provide excellent facilities, such as libraries, computer and science labs, sports centres, theatres and art studios.
- Cyprus, as a member of the Bologna Process, aims to enhance quality in HE and focuses on employability, lifelong learning, internationalization, student and staff mobility and student centred teaching approaches.

## **RESEARCH AND INNOVATION**

- 2021: research funding from external sources reached €30.1 million. UCY is currently participating in 349 projects. 201 are EU-funded projects under Horizon Europe, Horizon 2020, Erasmus+, Justice, Life, Cost Action and Interreg.
- 1<sup>st</sup> in securing funding from all organisations from the H2020 Widening countries (16 EU member states + 12 associated countries which are less advanced in R&I). Under this pillar, UCY secured 23 research projects with total funding of € 28.9 million (3 Teaming Phase 2 - € 23 million, 7 Teaming Phase 1 - € 1 million, 1 Era Chair - € 2.5 million, 4 Twinning - € 1.6 million and 8 Widening Fellowships - € 1.227.529)
- 137<sup>th</sup> in securing funding among 41,200 organizations participating in the Program and 98<sup>th</sup> among all the academic institutions involved.
- Highest number of ERC grants in Cyprus (23 grants) since the establishment of the European Research Council in 2007 (7 Starting Grants, 5 Consolidator Grants, 2 Advanced Grants, 8 Proof of Concept Grants and 1 Synergy Grant)
- **72 Marie Skłodowska-Curie projects** (28 Marie Skłodowska-Curie projects funded under Horizon 2020 and Horizon Europe)
